MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 2017 – 10

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE TYING OF HORSES, CARABAOS, COWS AND PIGS ALONG POBLACION STREETS IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF PALANAN, ISABELA.

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan in Session assembled that:

SECTION 1 – It is hereby prohibited to tie Horses, Carabaos, Cows and Pigs along Poblacion streets at any moment considering that these animals will cause erosions to edge of canals, causing the refill of canals with dirt and obstruction of our drainage system, thereby maximizing the cost of maintenance without mention to the unsanitary condition that these animals will contribute causing detrimental effects to human health;

SECTION 2 - Punong barangays of Centro West and Centro East, with coordination with the Municipal Sanitary Inspector and the support of the Sangguniang Barangay members and Barangay tanods are hereby ordered to help disseminate and implement this Ordinance in their respective Barangays;


SECTION 3 – SEPARABILITY CLAUSE – If for any reason, any provision, portion or part of this Ordinance found to be inconsistent with any Law, other provisions or part/s thereof not so affected shall remain in full force and effect;

SECTION 4 – REPEALING CLAUSE – All Ordinances, Rules and Regulations or parts thereof, in conflict with, or, contrary to, the Provisions of this Ordinance not so affected herewith is hereby repealed or modified accordingly;

SECTION 5 – EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE – This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval.
