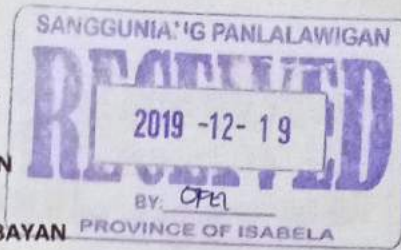

**MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 2019-20**

**AN ORDINANCE IMPLEMENTING STRATEGIES FOR THE REHABILITATION OF ALL RECOVERED PUBLIC ROADS CAUSED BY ROAD CLEARING OF ILLEGAL STRUCTURES AND CONSTRUCTIONS IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF PALANAN, ISABELA**

**WHEREAS**, it is hereby declared by the policy of the Local Government Unit to promote the general welfare, particularly the protection and security of the populace;

**WHEREAS**, the Local Government Code of 1991 mandates the power of Local Government to regulate all forms of transportation vehicles within its territorial jurisdiction to protect public interest and to promote the health, comfort, safety and welfare of the people.

**WHEREAS**, this Body ensures responsiveness to the Presidential Directive during the 4<sup>th</sup> State of the Nation Address (SONA), thus, formulate legislative measures/strategies to rehabilitate all recovered public roads affected by road clearing operations in this municipality;

**NOW THEREFORE**, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN OF PALANAN, ISABELA IN SESSION ASSEMBLED THAT:

**SECTION 1. Strategies/activities for the rehabilitation of recovered public roads**

1. Sidewalk streets:
  - a. Placing of street names and signages;
  - b. Installation of street lights and street names;
  - c. Allocation of fund for maintenance and repair of roads to be used as passageway;
2. Planting of trees – to replace the trees affected by road clearing.
3. Allocate fund for the maintenance of newly planted seedlings.

**SECTION 2. DEFINITION OF TERMS.** When used in this ordinance, the following terms and phrased shall mean:

- a. **Public Road** – it means all streets, roads (national, provincial, municipal and barangay roads, bridges, highways and other thoroughfares constructed and maintained by the national government or by any Local Government Unit. Provided, that any road or sidewalk not falling under this definition but which upon determination of this LGU, is deemed vital to pedestrian access or safety, shall be deemed a public road sidewalk.
- b. **Strategy** – a careful plan or method for achieving a particular goal usually over long period of time.
- c. **Installation**- the act or process a machine, a service, etc. ready to be used in certain place;
- d. **Street light** – a light usually mounted on a pole and constituting one of a series spaced at intervals along a public street or highway.

**SECTION 3. ENFORCEMENT.** The LGU Implementation Team, Members of the Palanan Police Force, Office of the Municipal Engineer, MENRO and Barangay Officials are hereby ordered to enforce the implementation of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 4. REPEALING CLAUSE.** All ordinances, rules and regulations or part thereof in conflict with, or contrary to, the provisions of this Ordinance not so affected herewith is hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

**SECTION 5. EFFECTIVITY.** This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.
