MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 2020-070

AN ORDINANCE INSTITUTIONALIZING THE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF PALANAN, ISABELA

BE IT ORDAINED by the Sangguniang Bayan of Palanan, Isabela in session assembled that:

SECTION 01. REGULATED ACTS. There is hereby established a Scholarship Program to "Poor but Deserving Students" in this Municipality.

SECTION 02. GENERAL PROVISIONS.

- a. The minimum amount of One Hundred Thousand Pesos (P 100,000.00) shall be appropriated annually and depends upon the availability of funds for this purpose.
- b. The amount appropriated shall be used to extend financial assistance to deserving individuals through Scholarship program/grant, the number of grantees may exceed Five (5) Students per year.
- c. The grantees shall be enrolled only in any public schools/state colleges/universities within the Province of Isabela after meeting the requirements set by the Committee on Education of the Sangguniang Bayan of Palanan; provided that previous grantees continue their studies in the school/college/university where the were initially enrolled.

SECTION 03. THE RULES AND REGULATIONS IMPLEMENTING THE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM.

These rules are promulgated to prescribe the procedures and guidelines for the implementation of the Scholarship Ordinance of the Municipality of Palanan in order to facilitate compliance therewith and achieve the objectives thereof.

SECTION 04. SCOPE AND APPLICATION. These rules shall apply to the following:

- a. All students enjoying the scholarship grant of the Municipality.
- b. All applicants to the said scholarship grant; and
- c. Involved personnel.

SECTION 05. QUALIFICATIONS AND REQUIREMENTS OF APPLICANT.

Any high school graduate, male or female who meets the following requirements may apply:

- a. Must be a Filipino citizen and a resident of Palanan, Isabela;
- b. Must have a general average of at least 85%;
- c. The income of the family of the beneficiary must not exceed the amount of P 50,000.00 per annum; and
- d. Must have a good moral record.

SECTION 06. SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS.

Interested applicants must submit their written applications to the Office of the Mayor on or before the month of April of each year together with the following:

- a. Application Letter;
- b. A photocopy of his/her DepEd Form 138 (Report Card);
- c. Certificate of good moral character signed by the Principal of the last school attended;
- d. Certificate of Tax Exemption from the BIR;

- e. Certification from the Punong Barangay;
- f. Bio-data; and
- g. One (1) copy of 2"x2" photo.

SECTION 07. TESTING AND SCREENING APPLICANTS.

The testing and screening of applicants shall be administered by the Office of the Municipal Mayor and SB Committee on Education. The screening shall be done within the Month of May of each year at the Legislative Session Hall of this Municipality.

SECTION 08. SELECTION CRITERIA. The manner of determining the selection grantees shall be as follows:

Scholastics	50%
Aptitude	25%
Values	25%
Total	----- 100% =====

The qualified applicants shall be automatically be considered as beneficiaries of the Scholarship grant and shall enjoy the same privileges granted to other recipients of the scholarship grant of the Municipality.

SECTION 09. PRIVILEGES.

The scholarship grantee shall enjoy the following privileges:

- a. Miscellaneous Fee (i.e. Entrance fee)
- b. Allowance

SECTION 10. LIMITATION. The grant shall only be extended to a student enrolled in any *public schools, colleges or universities with the Province of Isabela.*

SECTION 11. GROUNDS FOR DISQUALIFICATION.

The grantee shall continue to enjoy the privileges consequent to his/her being a scholar provided that he/she:

- a. Maintain a general average of **80% (2.50)** and should not have a final grade in any subject lower than **75% (3.00)**;
- b. Refrains from participating in any subversive activity;
- c. Abstains from any criminal activity; and
- d. Desists from committing any obscene/indecent act that causes serious damage to his/her honor and dignity as a person as well as to the name and honor of the Municipality;

SECTION 12. PAYMENT OF GRANTS AND ENROLLMENT.

The Office of the Municipal Treasurer shall be responsible for the payment of scholarship grants.

SECTION 13. GATHERING OF SCHOLARS.

The Office of the Mayor shall set time for a meeting of beneficiaries before the start and the end of every semester. The said meeting should be conducted to promote spirit of camaraderie among the scholars themselves as well as to plan on how they could be of better service to their community.

SECTION 14. ADDITIONAL PROVISIONS.

Grantees are expected further to actively participate in any civic activities sponsored and or introduced by the Municipal Government.

SECTION 15. FUNDING.

An initial funding shall be allocated under the **5% GAD or LCPC Funds** of this Municipality.


SECTION 16. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If any provision of this Ordinance found to be inconsistent with any law, other provisions or part/s thereof not so affected shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 17. REPEALING CLAUSE. All Ordinances, Rules and Regulations or parts thereof, in conflict with, or contrary to, the Provisions of this Ordinance not so affected herewith is hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 18. EFFECTIVITY. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval.
