MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 2020-047

AN ORDINANCE TRANSFERRING THE EMILIO AGUINALDO MARKER THEREBY ALLOWING THE RELOCATION FROM J.P.RIZAL STREET, BARANGAY DICABISAGAN WEST TO THE MUNICIPAL COMPOUND OF THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT OF PALANAN, ISABELA.

WHEREAS, there is an urgent need to transfer the site of Emilio Aguinaldo Marker within the Municipal Compound of this Local Government Unit in order to preserve the historic Aguinaldo Park due to continuous erosion of its present location;

WHEREAS, the Last Stand of the former 1st President of the Republic of the Philippines, General Emilio Aguinaldo commemorates the heroic capture in this remote coastal Municipality of Palanan, Isabela on March 23, 1901;

NOW THEREFORE, Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan of Palanan, Isabela in session assembled that;

SECTION 1. DECLARATION OF POLICY.

"Section 11 of the Local Government Code of 1991. Selection and transfer of Local government site, offices, and facilities (a) The law or ordinance creating or merging local government units shall specify the seat of government from where governmental and corporate services shall be delivered. In selecting said site, factors relating to the geographical centrality, accessibility, availability of transportation and communication facilities, drainage and sanitation, development and economic progress and other relevant considerations shall be taken into account."

SECTION 2. FUNDING. The Municipal Government of Palanan shall allocate fund necessary for the transfer, conservation/preservation and development of the historical marker and site to be sourced out from the MOOE of the Municipal Mayor of this municipality.

SECTION 3. IMPLEMENTORS. The Offices of the Municipal Engineering, Tourism and MPDC are hereby directed to implement the provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If any provision of this Ordinance found to be inconsistent with any law, other provisions or part/s thereof not so affected shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 5. REPEALING CLAUSE. All ordinances, rules and regulation or parts thereof whose provisions are in conflict with the provision of this Ordinance are hereby repealed, amended or modified accordingly.

SECTION 6. EFFECTIVITY- This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.

RESOLVED FINALLY, to forward copies of this Ordinance to the Office of the National Historical Commission of the Philippines, Manila and to Sangguniang Panlalawigan thru Honorable Faustino G. Dy, III, Provincial Vice Governor, Province of Isabela for their information, reference and appropriate action. Likewise to furnish copies of the same to all offices concerned for their information and reference.
