MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 2021-095

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 2012-03, AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING OWNERS/DRIVERS OF SINGLE MOTORCYCLES OPERATING WITHIN THE TERRITORIAL JURISDICTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY TO REGISTER THEIR MOTORCYCLES TO BE HANDLED BY PALANAN POLICE STATION AND IMPOSING PENALTIES THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the Local Government Code of 1991 provides that the Sangguniang Bayan, as the Legislative Body of the municipality, shall enact Ordinances for the general welfare of the municipality and its inhabitants;

WHEREAS, significant number of crime incidents particularly shooting and robbery being perpetrated by criminals using motorcycles without plate numbers and often than not, stolen ones;

WHEREAS, most of the criminal elements used car napped vehicles to conceal their identity and avoid being detected by the authorities from the crime they committed;

WHEREAS, it is necessary in the interest of public order, safety and security for the government to adopt and enforce adequate and effective measures to thwart crime incidents and neutralize personalities involved in all forms of illegal activities using motorcycles as mode of transportation to perpetrate crime and other nefarious activities;

WHEREAS, under the Letter of Instruction, all motorcycles are required to be registered at the Municipal Town Halls of their respective municipalities within the Region to protect the public and the owners of motorcycles, with the following requirements:

1. Original and Updated OR/CR of vehicle/motorcycle. The OR/CR of the vehicle must be registered under the name of the applicant;
2. Updated Driver's License;
3. OPLAN-VISA Receipt; and
4. 2 pcs. 1x1 ID picture;

WHEREAS, the Enhanced Oplan Visa campaign is one of the services offered by e-Serbisyo Lingkod Bayanihan initiated by the PNP Regional Director to lessen crimes involving motorcycle - riding suspects;

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan Members in session assembled:

SECTION 01. TITLE. This Ordinance shall be known as **"ENHANCED PALANAN OPLAN VISA"**.

SECTION 02. SCOPE. There shall be a Municipal Registration of all motorcycles of all citizens in the Municipality of Palanan to be handled by Palanan Police Station.

SECTION 03. DEFINITION OF TERMS.

VISA – shall mean verification of Identification and Sticker's Authenticity.

OPLAN SITA – Police operation to check on moving vehicles especially on motorcycles and other suspicious motor vehicles.

TRAFFIC CITATION TICKETS – a ticket issued to a person violating the traffic laws and shall show among other information, the name and address of the offender and include information that constitutes a complaint charging the offense.

SINGLE MOTORCYCLE- two-wheeled vehicle powered by fuel combustion.

SECTION 04. PRESCRIBED ACTS.

All owners/drivers of single motorcycle plying along municipal streets, roads, and highways within the territorial jurisdiction of Palanan, Isabela are hereby required to register their single motorcycle at the Palanan Police Station *through online application and submission of requirements via Facebook Messenger.*

The New *PALANAN OPLAN VISA* is an enhanced campaign initiated by the PNP to lessen crimes involving motorcycle-riding suspects, motorcycles running away secretly from mainland cities/municipalities and to effectively monitor the total number of motorcycles plying within the territorial jurisdiction of this Municipality.

SECTION 05. APPLICATION AND PAYMENTS FOR REGISTRATION. Citizens can file an application and submit their requirements via FB Messenger and payment shall be made at the Office of the Municipal Treasurer.

SECTION 06. SCHEDULE OF REGISTRATION FEES. Except as otherwise specifically provided in this Ordinance, each application for registration of motor vehicles shall be accompanied by one-time payment of the following fees in accordance with the following schedule:

Registration	: Five Hundred Pesos (P500.00)
Sticker/QR Code Fee(s)	: Two Hundred Pesos (P200.00)

SECTION 07. ISSUANCE OF STICKER AND QR CODE. A properly numbered sticker with unique color-coded features and QR Code shall be issued for each separate motor vehicle after due inspection and payment of corresponding registration fees.

SECTION 08. AUTHENTICATION FEATURES.

- a) The PNP and other authorized agencies can scan the authenticity of the sticker, if it is counterfeit/fake or originally issued by PNP.
- b) The motorcycle can be easily noticed, if it traveled to other towns or province making the apprehension more systematized.

SECTION 09. DIGITAL VALIDATION.

- a) Buyers of second hand motorcycles can check if the unit has any ownership issued by simply scanning the QR Code, entering the Engine or Chasis Number to FB Messenger even if they do not have DATA.
- b) Victims of hit and run can easily trace the owner of the motorcycle and even the driver with the assistance from PNP and other Authorized Agencies.

MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 2021-095: AN ORDINANCE AMENDING MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 2012-03, AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING OWNERS/DRIVERS OF SINGLE MOTORCYCLES OPERATING WITHIN THE TERRITORIAL JURISDICTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY TO REGISTER THEIR MOTORCYCLES TO BE HANDLED BY PALANAN POLICE STATION AND IMPOSING PENALTIES THEREOF.

SECTION 10. PENALTIES. The following penalties shall be imposed for violations of this Ordinance:

- a) When verified and found out to be unregistered with the *Enhanced Oplan Visa*, the owner shall be Reprimanded/ given Stern Warning for the **1st Offense**;

A Fine of Five Hundred Pesos (P500.00) for impounding fee and penalty for late registration, of which shall be a fine of Fifty Percent (50%) of the Registration Fee for **2nd Offense**;

- b) A Fine of Two Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (P2,500.00) for making, using or attempting to make or use the Sticker and QR Code or intended to be used as a legal sticker/QR or otherwise disposed of the same to another, or falsely or fraudulently represent as valid.

SECTION 11. NO CONTEST PROVISION. Any person or individual who is apprehended or cited for the violation of this Ordinance and who does not wish to contest the violation and is willing to pay voluntarily the fine imposed upon him/her prior to the filing of the formal charge with the proper court shall be allowed to pay **Twenty Five Percent (25%)** of the Registration Fee less of the imposable fine at the Office of the Municipal Treasurer to avoid being criminally prosecuted within twelve (12) hours from apprehension otherwise the case shall be prosecuted.

SECTION 12. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If for any reason, any provision, portion or part of this Ordinance found to be inconsistent with any Law, other provisions or part/s thereof not so affected shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 13. REPEALING/AMENDATORY CLAUSE. All ordinances, rules and regulations, or part/s thereof, which are inconsistent or in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed, amended and/or modified accordingly.

SECTION 14. EFFECTIVITY. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval and publication.
